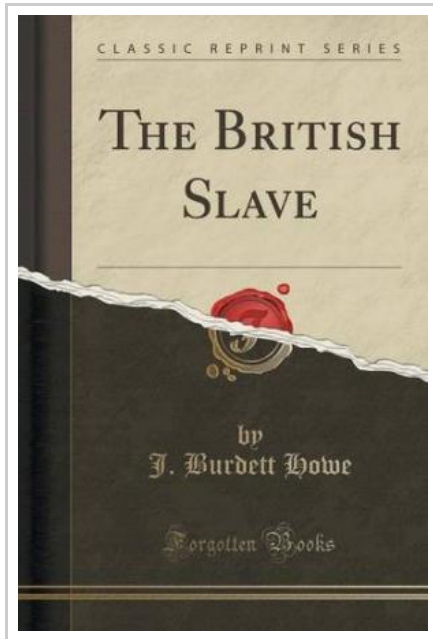




## The British Slave (Classic Reprint) (Paperback)
