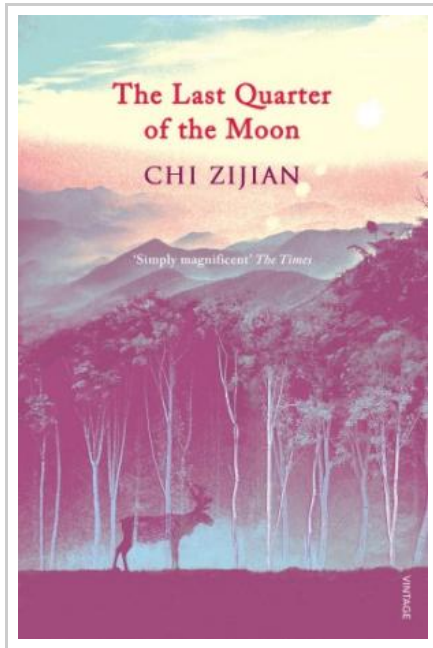




The Last Quarter of the Moon
