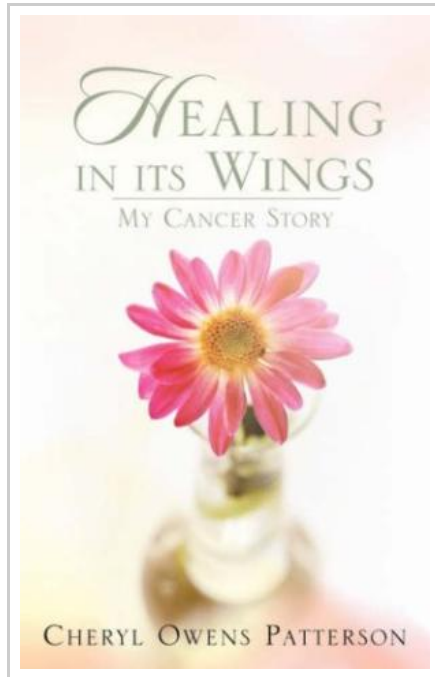




Healing in Its Wings
