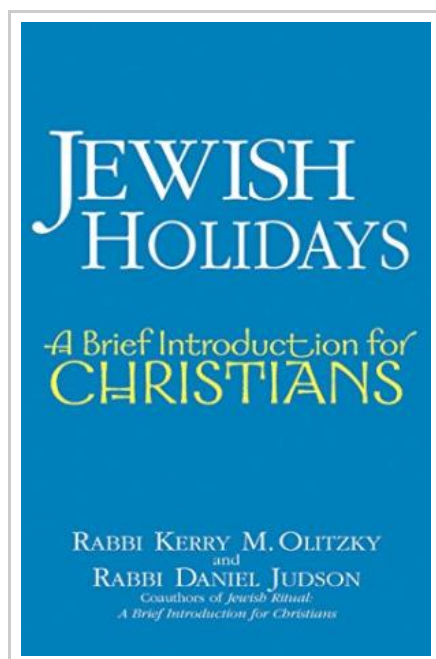




Jewish Holidays: A Brief Introduction for Christians (Paperback)
